Contraction UNO

Print and cut out cards

Procedures:

- Cards are shuffled and dealer deals five cards to each player.
 The remaining cards are placed face down and the top card is turned face up.
- 2. Players alternate and discard a card that fits the contraction pattern while saying the contraction form of the word, or by playing one of the special cards of skip, draw or wild.
- 3. Skip, Draw, and Wild cards may be used to move from one contraction pattern to another. If the player cannot discard from his hand, he must draw from the pile. Unless it is a draw 2 situation, he may discard if the card drawn follows the pattern.
- 4. As players alternate turns, they are attempting to discard all their cards. When a player has only one card remaining, they must say, "UNO." If they forget, and the other player sees that the opponent is down to one card, they call the fact to their opponent's attention and the opponent must then draw another card.
- 5. The first player out is the winner.
