## Contraction UNO

## Print and cut out cards

## Procedures:

1. Cards are shuffled and dealer deals five cardsto each player. The remaining cardsare placed face down and the top card is tumed face up.
2. Players altemate and discard a card that fits the contraction pattem while saying the contraction form of the word, or by playing one of the special cards of skip, draw or wild.
3. Skip, Draw, and Wild cards may be used to move from one contraction pattem to another. If the player cannot discard from his ha nd, he must draw from the pile. Unless it is a draw 2 situation, he may disc ard if the card drawn follows the pattem.
4. As players altemate tums, they are attempting to discard all their cards. When a player has only one card remaining, they must say, "UNO." If they forget, and the other player sees that the opponent is down to one card, they call the fact to their opponent'sattention and the opponent must then draw anothercard.
5. The first player out is the winner.
