A Court Jester

Copy the pattern on hard cardstock paper. Have the students to color and cut out. You can further decorate with glitter and sequins.

The second hole down on the arms and legs are for connecting with brads to the main body.

The first hole on the arm and legs are for connecting strong string. Tie a string horizontally from arm to arm. Tie another string horizontally from leg to leg. Tie a longer piece of string vertically, first knotting around the center of the string connecting the arms, continuing down to knotting around the center of the string connecting the legs, and then extending down between the legs. Now, pulling the string will make your court jester dance.
