

The following pages will help you to create a cabinet mini-book. First fold a sheet of paper into a shutter fold. Glue the first page on the center of that folded page with the center opening corresponding with the center line of the cabinet. Cut out the drawer section opening only so that you will have four flaps. Each name flap will open where you can then see on one side of the flap the office of the person and a lined section is on the other side of the opening with notes that the student writes about that individual. It is suggested that all coloring be done before cutting any of the pages if the student wishes to color.

The picture included on this page can be placed on the same section of a lapbook or on the same background page of a notebook page if so desired.
